RULES & REGULATIONS

1. System of Play : The Tournament will be played under FIDE's Laws of Chess and the Swiss system. Number of rounds and time control mentioned in the brochure on Page 1 for the 6 events.
2. Appeals Committee : Before the commencement of the tournament, a five member appeals committee shall be formed. Protest, if any, shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs. 1000/- within 15 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.
3. The Chief Arbiter's decision on all matters related to play shall be final and binding.
4. Electronic Devices: All electronic items including wrist watches (all type of watches) are not allowed in the tournament hall.
5. Latest FIDE tie-break rules will be used. As per AICF Regulations.
6. Walkover time is full time for all tournaments.
7. Prizes will not be shared, one player is eligible for one higher prize only.
8. Registration to this event is an automatic consent given by the player for recording or capturing his/her games or pictures during the round.
9. There will be DGT boards used in the event. All games will also be uploaded on the chessworldai database.
10. The organisers have the right to reject any entry without assigning a reason.
11. The organisers reserve the right to modify the tournament schedule (round timings, pairing announcements, etc.) in case of unforeseen circumstances.
12. Misconduct or indecent behavior towards arbiters, players, or officials will lead to immediate expulsion without refund and blacklisted from future events. RCC has never cancelled nor postponed a tournament till date.
13. Breakfast, Tea, coffee, snacks, lunch, dinner and bottled drinking water will be available at the venue on a chargeable basis at reasonable rates. Free canned drinking water will be available for the players.
14. Participants and accompanying persons are not required to buy food or beverages from the organizers and may bring their own if they wish.
15. The organizer's decisions regarding facilities and general arrangements shall be final and binding.
16. Very strictly no refund will be processed in case of cancellation of entry.
17. Very strictly no entry can be transferred to another player.
18. Gala Dinner Party by RCC on 29/03/2026 is free for all participants and their accompanying persons.
